**Application:** Identifying the Application for the intended audience as well as for us today.

After the Bible Interpretation work is completed, we will learn to outline a passage by picking out the theme and its main points and organizing them. Each participant will be given an assignment where they will be given a passage to study and then to present it back to the class in a 20-minute sermon.
