Update From Akmal at Naomi House:

Hakimi Children (Five Orphans)

We thank God that all five Hakimi children have now received their Afghan passports, which were issued in Kabul. This is a significant milestone. Their Pakistani visa approvals have already been granted by the Pakistani Embassy in Kabul, and we are currently waiting for the physical visa documentation to be issued. The next step will be visa stamping by the Border Security Police. Once that process is completed, the agent will arrange for the passports to be safely delivered to Peshawar, Pakistan. While there are still a few steps remaining, we are encouraged by this progress and continue to monitor the situation closely.

Arif Mohammadi and Meerwais Zeerak

Unfortunately, we faced a serious setback with Arif and Meerwais. They were **arrested in Pakistan** and held in a detention center for approximately two weeks before being **deported to Afghanistan**. At the time of their arrest, they were not permitted to collect their belongings. As a result, **their passports and personal items—including their Bibles—remain in Pakistan**. They are currently staying in a **small town near Nangarhar, close to the Pakistan border**. For their safety, they are unable to travel to Kabul, as the Taliban maintain strong control there, and recognition could lead to severe consequences. **We have since sent financial support** to help them obtain essential personal items and stabilize their situation. They have been advised to maintain a **very low profile for their safety**.

Once their situation becomes more stable, **we plan to assist them in obtaining duplicate passports** so that we can resume the process of helping them reach safety.
